If there's one thing being part of a wine family teaches you, it's the need for patience. When you plant a vine, it takes at least three years - sometimes four - to produce the first crop of grapes. If those grapes are red, it takes another two to three (or more) years to produce wine from them. That's at least five+ years from plant to bottle! Growing up at Flora Springs, I learned this firsthand, and so when I set out to make changes to our wines and packaging, I was prepared to be patient. That was about four or so years ago, and at long last, 2024 is the year we'll see my work come to fruition. I can't wait to

unveil and share new wines with you in the coming months.

In the meantime, I hope you'll consider joining Anne and I next fall on our luxury cruise to Asia, including both modern and historical cities and sites in both Japan and South Korea. This will be a feast for the senses in more ways than one, a chance to immerse yourself in foreign landscapes and cultures while enjoying the familiar wines you love. 2021 POGGIO DEL PAPA

Our Poggio del Papa pays tribute to the Sangiovese-centered red wine blends found in the Tuscany region of Italy. Our Sangiovese is sourced from southern Napa Valley where the cooler microclimate allows the grape to maintain good structure and natural acidity, a key characteristic of the varietal. Small amounts of Zinfandel, Merlot and Malbec, sourced from slightly warmer, mid-valley vineyards, add lush fruit and juicy plumpness to the wine.

The 2021 Poggio del Papa is a polished red wine with lively flavors of cherry, wild berry, fresh herb and mineral that harmonize beautifully. With good density and a fleshy texture, the wine is supported by light, firm tannins and lively acidity. Order up your favorite pizza, turn on the game and sit back and relax with "Papa."

Returning to Napa, we determined to make our own Sangiovese, sourcing fruit from the cooler southern regions of the valley with the right soils and growing conditions for this signature grape.

Our 2021 Sangiovese will have you dreaming of the Tuscan hills, with cherry and cranberry flavors that are fresh and bright along with notes of vanilla, spice and fresh herbs. This is a smooth, supple red with lively acidity and light, well-integrated tannins. Open this up, get out an Italian guidebook, and plan your next trip to Italy!
